RESULTS:

Item 1 Human deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA) was isolated from Eilin Walsh's vaginal/cervical swab and underpants. These samples were amplified and typed at the HLA DQA1 locus and in the PM system loci (which includes the LDLR, G2PA, HFGG, D7S8, and G3 loci). Refer to the table for the typing results of these samples.

Because no blood sample was received from Eilin Walsh in the Physical Evidence Recovery Kit, her saliva swab was used to try to obtain her known DNA profile at the above specified loci. However, due to degradation, no typing results could be obtained at the HLA DQA1 locus or PM system for the saliva swab.

The remaining items in the Physical Evidence Recovery Kit were not examined.

Item 2 The sweat shirt was not examined.

Item 3 The sweat pants were not examined.

Item 4 The cigarette butt was not examined.

Item 5 The red and white cord was not examined.
