CONCLUSIONS:

The DNA profiles obtained from the sperm fractions of the vaginal/cervical swabs (Item 1) and underpants (Item 1), and the non-sperm fraction from the underpants (Item 1) are consistent with a mixture of the DNA profiles of Alexander Cameron (Item 11) and another individual. Therefore, Alexander Cameron cannot be eliminated as a possible contributor of the genetic material detected on the underpants or the genetic material detected in the sperm fraction of the vaginal/cervical swab.

The DNA profile obtained from the non-sperm fraction of the vaginal/cervical swab (Item 1) is different from that of Alexander Cameron (Item 11). Therefore, he is eliminated as a contributor of the genetic material detected in the non-sperm fraction of the vaginal/cervical swab.

No further DNA analysis can be conducted on the vaginal/cervical swab (Item 1) from Elin Walsh.

Further DNA (RFLP) analysis may be possible if blood samples from Elin Walsh and Alexander Cameron are submitted to the laboratory, along with Elin Walsh's underpants (Item 1) and the fitted bed sheet (Item 7).

The evidence is being returned to the Northern Laboratory where it will be available for personal pickup.
