Q. Officer, would you please tell me what your tour of duty and assignment was on this date?

A. I was working the 4P-12<sup>00</sup> tour of duty and assigned to 198 RPC. At approx. 6:05 P.M. I responded to Pol. Prosser stating that he had two dead bodies inside of 146 N. Millick St. I proceeded to the scene and upon arrival I entered the premises, and I observed a Black female on the dining room floor near the basement steps lying face up under some clothes nude from the waist down, and then I proceeded to the basement of the premises, and I observed that there was a male going down to the basement and he was the father of three three boys who were in the house, and I stopped him from going down, and I stayed upstairs with him. I never saw the second female.

1. Did you have an opportunity to speak with any of the children inside of the house?

A. Yes en route to the Homicide division I spoke to Keith Smallwood, and he he told me that this guy named Darryl came to the house around 1:00 or 2:00 in the morning, and that was the first time that he ever saw him. His Aunt Rose told the male Darryk that he could not stay at the house, he said that he heard them arguing, and he had his brother Kyle and Kevin came out of the back bedroom to see what was going on, and his mother, Pam told him to go back in the room. He continued to hear arguments between his aunt and this guy Darryl. Then he went to sleep. About 6:00 A.M. he woke up and he heard his mother and Darryl arguing in the front bedroom. He said that the guy told him to get back in his room. This all happened after he woke up. He said that later he came out of the back bedroom looking for his mother. He went downstairs towards the dining room, and he noticed that Darryl was in the basement and he asked Darryl where his mother was, and Darryl told him that she went to work, and for him to get back in the room. He said that later Darryl came upstairs and played video games with the kids. He told me that his father, Keith Smallwood came to the house this evening, and that he came through the window. He also said earlier when his mother did not come home from work around 5:00 P.M. he wanted to use the phone, and Darryl took the battery out of the cordless phone. Why would I take battery out all I had to do was not let him use the phone
