Q. Officer, would you please tell me what your tour of duty and assignment was on this date?

A. I was working the 4P-12A tour of duty and assigned 1901 EPW. At approx. 6:05 P.M. we responded to a radio call from Pol. Prosser that he had two dead bodies in 146<sup>th</sup> Millick St. We went to the scene, and when we got to the scene I looked in from the outside and I could see a body of a person on the dining room floor with something covering her. A girl by the name of Delicia and a male by the name of Keith Smallwood came outside. I asked them who the victim were, and she gave me the information. There were three little boys outside, and I placed them in a squad car, and I started to talk to them. I asked them what happened, and it took a while, because they were crying. Keith who was the oldest of them said to me that his Aunt Rose was strangled. He said that the guy that was in the police car did it. He said that his name was Darryl. I asked him what happened, and he said that he talked to his mom this morning (Pam). He said that Darryl had locked him in a bedroom, and he said that he was in his Mom's bedroom

He said that there were blankets against the door, and everytime he asked where his mother was, Darryl would tell him that she had gone to work. He told me that Darryl would give him something to drink, and we would like him, and then we wouldn't like him because he wouldn't tell us where his mother was. He told me that Darryl was just trying to be their friend, and con him.

Q. Did you ever enter the premises?

A. No.

Q. Did you transport anyone to the Homicide Division?

A. Yes, he gave my partner Pol. Ron Cain #4959 a name of Arnim Evans B/M 29 he told us that he lived at 5814 Windsor Ave. He said that his DOB was 11-4-11-30-67.

Q. Did he give you any statement at all or say anything at all to you?

A. He said something to Ron, Ron placed him in the wagon while I was talking to the kids and Delicia.

Q. Did Kevin Smallwood say anything to you?

A. He said the same as Keith did basically, he also said that this morning he asked for cereal. and Darryl took him downstairs to get it and he brought it back upstairs to the bedroom. He said that Darryl was also playing the video games.
