Q. Officer, would you please tell me what your tour of duty and assignment was on this date?

A. I was working the 4P-12A tour of duty with my partner Pol Daniel Wilson 5137. We were assigned to 19 M1 and 2. We heard Pol. Prosser come over the radio that there were two bodies inside of 146 N. Millick St. We went to that location and upon arrival we observed police officers bring out a male from that location. Then we both entered the property and I observed when I walked in the body of a female on the dining room floor covered with clothes. She was face, and nude from the waist down. Her pants were down to her knees. She had a rag in her mouth, she wasn't tied. Her hands were up around her chest area. I proceeded to the basement and the bottom of the stairs I observed another of a Black female she was face up nude from the waist up, and gray sweat pants. She was tied with her hands behind her back with a yellow cord. She had a black and tan scarf. I felt for a pulse, and there was none. Lt. Woods was on the scene. I checked the rest of the house. I establish a crime scene with my partner Pol. Wilson

A. I spoke to Keith Smallwood and he told me that this guy Darryl had told
to stay in the bedroom and when he tried to come downstairs, Darryl took him

Q. Did you observe anything else at the house?
