Q. Can you tell me what you know about what happened inside of 146 n Millick st. on 3/22/97?

A. I was outside on my porch on 3/22/97 at approx. 12:00pm when I saw Pam Blue who lives at 146 n Millick st. she was outside the door. I talked to her about my grandmothers funeral. After this Pam went inside her house and I went inside to watch a movie. While watching the movie I started hearing noises like kids hollering and screaming. This was between 1:30pm - 2:00pm. I thought it was the people next store because they have teenage kids who make alot of noise all the time. I then went back to watching the movie. I heard noises again at 2:30pm while watching another movie. At around 5:30pm - 6:00pm I heard little kids noises. It was screaming. I heard the kids screaming "NO and STOP". I knew these as Pamela's kids but I didn't think anything was wrong. At about 6:15pm I went outside listening to what the kids were saying. I then heard "NO and then HEPL ME, HELP ME." I knew ~~was~~ there was something wrong by the tone of their voice. I then went into my house and dialed 911. I told the 911 operator that there is something wrong at the house at 146 n Millick st. The lady then said she would send a car out. I then went back outside. By then Keith who is the father of Pam's children was driving down the street with a police car behind him. I then started walking towards Pam's house at 146 n Millick st. I got to the steps at 146 n Millick st. when Keith knocked on the door but their was no

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answer. At this time the police officer came onto the porch. Keith then broke the front window. The police officer tried to kick the front door in but he couldn't. At this time I went back into my house and went out the back of the house to see if anybody was coming out the back of Pam's house or was in the yard. Nobody was out there. I then went back out to the front of Pam's house where the police officer had a black male on the ground on the porch and he was handcuffing him. The police officer also was talking into his radio for help. At this time the police told me to get off the porch.

Q. Were you present when the kids were brought out of 146 n Millick st. ?

A. Yes, the officer told me to take them to the police car.

Q. Did you hear any of the kids say what happened?

A. Keith the son of Pam and Keith said to Kim my sister "ROSEY DEAD". Then Kim said WHO DID IT Keith said "DARRYL". Then Keith said they had us in their for FIVE(5) hours. Then Kim said who had you in there for five hours. Keith said them. Kim asked Keith who them was. Keith said I don't know them. At this time I walked away. I then went over to the police car to get a closer look at the black male the police had handcuffed.

Q. Do you know the black male the police had handcuffed on the porch?

A. I don't know but I've seen him around the neighborhood.

Q. If you saw him again could you identify him?

A. YES.

Q. CAN You describe the black male the police had on the porch?

A. White sweatshirt, dark pants, I think he had on sneakers.

Q. Do you know who lives in 146 n Millick st?

A. Pamela Blue and Rose Youngblood

Q. How long have they lived in 146 n Millick st.?
