Q/ Did you know either of the decedents in this case?

A/ Yes. Roseann YOUNG was my aunt and Pam BLUE was the mother of my children (Keith Jr 9, Kevin 8, and Kyle 8 SMALLWOOD).

Q/ Who owns the house at 146 N. Millick Street?

A/ My Mother, Ann CHRISTIAN. The house was originally my grandmother's (Vivian YOUNG) and when she died eight years ago, my mother took it over. Roseann YOUNG was my mother's adopted sister.

Q/ Who was living in the house now?

A/ Roseann, her daughter (Sequoia) Pam, and my three children were living there.

Q/ When did you last see or speak to either Roseann or Pam?

A/ Yesterday, I called the house and talked to Roseann, this was about 3:00PM. I wanted to talk to Pam to tell her about a friend who got a job with me. She asked if I could come and get the kids this weekend because she had a date on Saturday night. I told her that I couldn't get them tonight (Friday) because Roy Jones Jr. Was fighting on HBO. I told her that I'd be there first thing in the morning (Saturday). She said okay. This morning (3-22-97) about 10:00am, I called Pam's house but nobody answered. I went over around 11:00am and blew the horn outside. Nobody answered the door when I went up and knocked and banged on the window. So then I left and went home. While I was home, Pam's girlfriend Delisia came over to my house. Roseann was baby-sitting her baby. Delisia said that she had been trying to get in touch with them all day and wasn't able to. She said that it wasn't like them not to be there or answer the phone. I had called Pam's father in Southwest Philly after I got home and he said that her and the kids weren't there. Delisia or my wife (Paula SMALLWOOD) called the Police from my house and asked them to meet us at Pam's house. The Police were there when we got there. I went up with the Police and knocked on the door.

Nobody answered so I tried to kick the door down. I couldn't get the door open so I pushed in the Plexiglas on the front porch window in and went inside the house. When I went into the house, I saw a guy coming down the stairs from the second floor. I never saw the guy before. He asked "Who the fuck is that?" and I asked him "Who the fuck are you?". He said "I'm Darryl, I'm Kia's friend. Kia is Roseann's girlfriend. She doesn't live there. I saw when Darryl was coming downstairs, that my kids were at the top of the stairs, coming from the back room. I didn't see Roseann or Pam or any other adults there. I asked Darryl where Pam and Roseann were. He said that Pam was at work and that he and Roseann had an argument and she left and locked the door. (The door is a double key lock which required a key on both sides of the door to open the lock). When I first went inside, I tried to unlock the door to let the policeman in but there was no key in the lock. I asked him why he didn't answer the door or the phone because I had been calling all day and Darryl said that Roseann told them not to answer the door. I told my kids to get their stuff and Delisia was gathering up her two children. We were up on the second floor of the house getting the kids together and Darryl was downstairs on the first floor at the window. The police were still outside on the porch. A police officer asked me what did I want to do about this guy (Darryl) and I told them that I didn't know him and that he had to get out of the house. I told the police not to let him go, to get his name or something to find out who he is. I went back upstairs to my kids and I asked them why they didn't come to the door when they heard the horn and they said that he (Darryl) wouldn't let them answer the door and he was pushing them. I started coming at Darryl saying "You were pushing these kids? They're my kids", then one of the kids said that he wasn't pushing them. I started back upstairs and I heard Darryl say "I wasn't pushing them" so I asked the kids where Darryl was when I was knocking on the door and they said that he was in the basement. I went downstairs towards the basement and my foot kicked something under a coat on the floor near the door. I looked under the coat and saw that it was Roseann. When I first kicked the coat, I hit something that was stiff and hard. Roseann's eyes were partially open and she had something stuffed in her mouth. I hollered and started crying and I told the police not to let Darryl go because he killed Roseann. Then I went to look in the basement and I saw something white like a sheet on the bottom of the stairs and I didn't want to go down to look. I was afraid that it was Pam. I never went down. The police went downstairs while I waited upstairs.

Q/ Have you ever seen Darryl before today?

A/ No.

Q/ Did any of the children saw when Darryl came to the house?

A/ I think they said that Pam told them that Darryl shouldn't have come to the house late at night.

Q/ Did the kids say when they last saw Pam and Roseann?

A/ They said that they saw Pam this morning. I didn't ask them when they saw Roseann.
