STATEMENT

- 01: This is Detective John Davis of the Guernsey Co. Sheriff's Dept.  
02: The date is June 25, 1997. The time now is 11:30 a.m. With me here at  
03: the Butler County Prison is John R. LaFollette, also Detective Ron  
04: Pollock.  
05: D. John, for the purpose of this tape, are you aware that you are being  
06: tape recorded?  
07: L. Yes sir I am.  
08: D. John, before we turned the tape recorder on, Detective Pollock read to  
09: you something commonly known as your Miranda Rights. Do you remember him  
10: reading those rights to you?  
11: L. Yes sir I do.  
12: D. And do you have any questions concerning your rights?  
13: L. No sir.  
14: D. And are you giving this statement of your own free will?  
15: L. Yes sir.  
16: D. John, uh....there was an incident I believe Captain....or excuse me,  
17: Arnold VanHorn and Detective Pollock had talked to you approximately a  
18: week or so ago concerning the Sinnett murder case.  
19: L. Yes sir.  
20: D. That happened in our county. Since going back and reviewing some of  
21: the stuff, we wanted to come back today and talk to you about some stuff,  
22: along with some other paperwork we had to do. Can you tell us, first of  
23: all, we'll go back to about the license plates on the car. Okay, what can  
24: you tell us about the license plates on the car being on the car one day  
25: and off the car and on the car and off the car?  
26: L. I really couldn't tell you anything about that because the day...the  
27: day before this...this stuff happened, the plates was on and the day that  
28: I sent them after a case of beer, they was on. I know they was on.  
29: D. Okay, that would of been uh...Saturday the day Mr. Sinnett was killed?  
30: L. Yes sir.  
31: D. Okay, where were you guys at that day?  
32: L. At Mia's house, Mia Andrews.  
33: D. Okay there in Buffalo?  
34: L. Yes sir.  
35: D. Okay, and you asked them to go buy some beer and you stayed at Mia's  
36: house. Is that correct?  
37: L. Yes.  
38: D. Okay, who all stayed there with you?  
39: L. That was me, Mia, her daughters and her son.  
40: D. Okay, and uh....who all went to get the beer?

## STATEMENT

- 01: L. Uh...Albert Andrews and Skippy Roberts.  
02: D. Okay, and the plates were on the car when they left?  
03: L. Yes sir.  
04: D. Okay, when they come back....  
05: L. As far...as far as I know.  
06: D. As far as you know, okay. When they come back, they had the beer.  
07: Is that correct?  
08: L. Exactly.  
09: D. Okay, did you get in the car with them at that point?  
10: L. No sir I didn't.  
11: D. Okay, what happened then?  
12: L. I got a 12 pack of beer out of the backseat, took it in the house, got  
13: a beer out of the back...or out of the package, went...went outside and  
14: stood on the porch and they yelled over at me, asked me if I wanted to go  
15: for a ride.  
16: D. But were they still in the car at that time?  
17: L. Yes sir.  
18: D. Okay.  
19: L. I said....you know, I said, "yes we'll go for a ride." Mia was in the  
20: shower....getting a shower at the time. I said, "well, we'll go for a  
21: ride." Just go and cruise around like we've done before and drink a beer.  
22: D. Right.  
23: L. So uh...when...when I got to the car, we went straight to Leo  
24: Sinnett's house.  
25: D. Okay.  
26: L. Okay, Chip stayed in the car...  
27: D. Chip was driving. Is that correct?  
28: L. Yes sir.  
29: D. Okay, you were in the right rear?  
30: L. Behind the dri....  
31: D. Or left?  
32: L. Yeah left, the driver's side.  
33: D. Okay.  
34: L. Okay, I said, "well this is pretty cool." I said, "go ahead and check  
35: this out" because Jack Siddle told me...asked me if I wanted to do a tree  
36: job for him, it had already been started and uh....  
37: D. Never got finished?  
38: L. Never got...exactly, never got finished, so I was like, cool. So I  
39: walked around the house. I looked at the tree and uh...started back  
40: around the house.  
41: D. Okay, when you started back around the house, was it back around the  
42: front part or back around the rear part?  
43: L. Well, it was right there along the road by the side of the cemetery.  
44: D. Okay.  
45: L. Okay, walked around that way and I almost...I made it probably about  
46: five feet away from the door and here comes Skip.  
47: D. Okay, which door would that be, the front door or back door?  
48: L. Front door.  
49: D. Okay.  
50: L. Yeah, the front door to the slab there.

## STATEMENT

01: D. Okay.  
02: L. Okay, I started towards the door and he's coming out and he said,  
03: "there's no need in trying to talk to him, he's dead." I...I was just  
04: freaked out. I said, "lets go."  
05: D. Can you describe Mr. Roberts? I mean, how was he dressed at that  
06: point or...?  
07: L. He had a pair of blue jeans on with boots, black t-shirt.  
08: D. Okay, did he have anything on his hands or anything?  
09: L. He was...he was covered from his hands to his elbows in blood.  
10: D. Okay, both hands or one certain hand?  
11: L. Right hand was covered with blood, left hand was pretty much too.  
12: D. Okay, did he have any blood on his clothes and stuff?  
13: L. Yes sir.  
14: D. Okay, I...I believe you already indicated this to Mr. Pollock on the  
15: last statement that he took off of you. Is that correct?  
16: L. Yeah.  
17: D. Where did you guys park the car at?  
18: L. Right in front.  
19: D. Right in front the house?  
20: L. Right...right directly in front of the house. Right in front of the  
21: door. Well, a little bit past the door.  
22: D. Alright, uh...so once you got back in the car, what happened?  
23: L. Started down the road. We just went straight down the road and hit  
24: Vocational Road, went out to 313 turn and a state patrol pulled right up  
25: behind us, pulled us over.  
26: D. Okay, did anybody...did Mr. Roberts say anything to you at that point  
27: after you got stopped by the state patrol while you was inside the car?  
28: What did he say?  
29: L. He said..he said..."don't say anything, don't say nothing" which I was  
30: never questioned, I never said anything to nobody at all. The cop, the  
31: state patrol said, "what did you fellows do, just murder somebody?"  
32: D. Okay.  
33: L. And the uh..statement that Skip made was, "no, we just hit a deer and  
34: gutted a deer."  
35: D. Okay, but you didn't say anything at that point?  
36: L. I never said anything.  
37: Pollock: Lets back up, when you got in the car, after Skip had told you  
38: that he killed Mr. Sinnett, what did Chip say?  
39: L. Nothing.  
40: Pollock: Did Chip know that he had killed?  
41: L. No sir I don't think. I don't think anybody knew that it was going to  
42: happened, but Skip.  
43: Pollock: Now lets back up a few days prior to that. Lets go back to  
44: Thursday.  
45: L. Okay.  
46: Pollock: You guys was out riding around?  
47: L. Yeah.  
48: Pollock: Who all was in the car?  
49: L. It was me, Mia...me and Mia was in the backseat  
50: D. Okay, Mia?

## STATEMENT

01: L. Andrews, uh...Skippy was driving the car, Chip was in the passenger  
02: side of the car.  
03: D. And you and Mia was in the backseat?  
04: L. Yes sir.  
05: D. Okay.  
06: L. Uh...we were cruising around and uh...Chip says, "well, I know  
07: somebody that's got some money, lets go roll."  
08: D. Okay, where was you at, at this point?  
09: L. I believe we was in Zanesville.  
10: D. Okay, can you..do you know what you was doing in Zanesville or was you  
11: just going to bars over there or what?  
12: L. No, I...I didn't really know what was going on until things....I was  
13: just there drinking, you know, just met Mia Andrews, you know, trying to..  
14: you know.  
15: D. So you guys ended up going to Zanesville?  
16: L. Ended up going to Zanesville. They was going to get drugs.  
17: D. Okay.  
18: L. That's what it ended up being.  
19: D. Okay.  
20: L. Which I had nothing to do with.  
21: Pollock: You've never used drugs, but anyway you went over there and  
22: bought some drugs.  
23: L. Exactly and uh...  
24: Pollock: And Chip needed some money?  
25: L. Yeah, Chip says, "well...." They didn't get the right amount of stuff  
26: so they didn't have no more money. Mia wasn't giving up no more money to  
27: them. So Chip says, "well, I know of somebody that we can go roll."  
28: D. Okay this is....  
29: L. Talking to Skip or yeah, Skippy or whatever his name is.  
30: D. Roberts.  
31: L. Roberts.  
32: D. Okay, now this is Thursday, right?  
33: L. Yeah.  
34: D. Okay.  
35: L. And so...  
36: Pollock: What did Roberts say?  
37: L. He said, "to hell rolling him." He said, "we'll just kill him."  
38: Pollock: Okay, did he say who it was?  
39: L. No, it was never said.  
40: Pollock: Okay, what did Mia say?  
41: L. She said, "hell, I'll just go buy another case of beer."  
42: D. Okay, did Mia...did you guys ever talk about if you guys would  
43: really rob this guy or...or whatever was going to happen, did they ever  
44: discuss or did you guys ever discuss, as to what you was going to do with  
45: the money?  
46: L. No, I kind of figured after....after that night what they was going  
47: to do with the money.  
48: D. Was going to buy the drugs?  
49: L. Yeah.  
50: D. Okay, did Mia...how much money or stuff was.....

## STATEMENT

01: L. How much money did Mia give them, \$100.00.  
02: D. Okay, how much money was Mia suppose to receive back if they...if they  
03: took some money? Do you have any idea?  
04: L. Uh...I think she was going to get uh...\$125.00 plus what Chip owed  
05: her from previous.....  
06: D. So they were going to try to get this off this person that they were  
07: going to rob or kill and then Mia was suppose to get \$125.00 or whatever  
08: she owed or....  
09: Pollock: Whatever they owed her back.  
10: L. Whatever they owed her back plus like \$25.00 for interest.  
11: D. Right.  
12: L. Okay.  
13: Pollock: So they were paying her interest on the money.  
14: L. On the money that she loaned them.  
15: Pollock: And she knew that...she was there when they said that and she  
16: knew that she was going to get the money back from that, from the robbery?  
17: L. See, that...that wasn't never brought up right then, you know, you  
18: know what I'm saying. They didn't say anything about going to rob him  
19: and give her the money back like that, no. It wasn't said like that.  
20: D. Okay.  
21: Pollock: Okay.  
22: L. Okay, he was suppose to have some money coming, Skip was suppose to  
23: have some money coming. Chip had money coming from uh...unemployment or  
24: whatever...not unemployment, but....  
25: Pollock: Federal Income Tax.  
26: L. Yeah, income tax, okay. And that's what I figured, you know, they  
27: was going to pay the money back.  
28: D. But they didn't say that?  
29: L. Chip said that, yes Chip did say that, that he would pay her out of  
30: his income tax whenever it come in. He was waiting on the money. I..I  
31: had been down there for a week, you know, and he had been borrowing money  
32: and staying with her.  
33: D. Did they ever discuss what they all....uh...you know, you mentioned...  
34: talking about maybe buying some drugs. Did they ever say how much money  
35: they was going to try to get?  
36: L. No.  
37: Pollock: How did Chip...how did Chip know this guy had a lot of money?  
38: L. I have no idea.  
39: Pollock: He never said, other than he just said he knew of a guy they  
40: could roll and they could get the money.  
41: L. Yeah, and they would get some money.  
42: Pollock: Okay, so Mia was in the car and what did she...she said that she  
43: would go buy a case of beer.  
44: L. "Hell, I'll just go buy a case of beer, it ain't no big deal."  
45: Pollock: What did they say?  
46: L. "I rather have some drugs, I rather have some cocaine."  
47: D. Was Mia suppose to get any of the money out of this at all that you  
48: know of?  
49: L. No sir.  
50: D. Okay, that you know of?

## STATEMENT

- 01: L. Not that I know of...I'm sure she did.  
02: D. Okay, what happened....  
03: L. I'm sure she didn't have anything to do with any of it.  
04: D. Okay, what happened Friday?  
05: L. Friday....  
06: D. Was you guys still out riding around and cruising around?  
07: L. No response.  
08: D. Thursday you guys were in Zanesville. What was you guys doing Friday?  
09: L. Getting drunk.  
10: D. Okay.  
11: Pollock: Okay.  
12: L. Getting drunk....well Friday I got into a fist fight with...with Rick  
13: Woods.  
14: Pollock: Right.  
15: D. Right.  
16: L. Okay, and that's the same day I went down to talk to Jackie Dean and  
17: he had told me that about the tree job over at Leo Sinnett's. I didn't  
18: really even know Leo. I knowed his daughter, Sandy and uh....Lip's wife.  
19: I can't even remember her name. But that's how I know of Leo, you know,  
20: because of, you know. I...when we stopped there, that's what I thought,  
21: you know. He went...he went in there. I didn't know what for. I knew  
22: what I got out of the car for.  
23: D. Okay, when you got back in the car and you guys got stopped by the  
24: patrol and stuff, the patrol eventually took you to a residence on 313.  
25: Is that correct?  
26: L. Yes sir.  
27: D. Okay, did Skippy Roberts change his clothes there or anything?  
28: L. No sir.  
29: D. Okay, you eventually I believe called your sister. Is that right?  
30: L. Yes sir I did.  
31: D. Okay, and she come down there and picked you up?  
32: L. Yeah.  
33: D. And correct me if I'm wrong, uh...eventually you guys ended up at  
34: the Spirit Lounge?  
35: L. Yes sir, Skippy told my sister that he would give her some money to  
36: go pick up Chip from the highway patrol barracks.  
37: D. Did...did Chip or Skip ever say where he got this money from?  
38: L. No sir.  
39: D. Okay, did he have much money on him that day?  
40: L. No sir.  
41: D. Okay, later on in that evening he had....  
42: L. He had money.  
43: D. Did he have a lot of money?  
44: L. No, I wouldn't say a lot of money, probably a couple hundred anyway.  
45: D. Okay, uh....but he didn't have that much on him prior to going into  
46: Mr. Sinnett's house?  
47: L. No.  
48: D. Okay, so once you got...  
49: L. Because I had...I had sent them after beer.  
50: D. And you had to pay for that?

## STATEMENT

01: L. I had to pay for that. They had no money and like I said, Mia was not  
02: going to give them no more money until she got her money back.  
03: D. Okay.  
04: Pollock: So they had to come up with some money one way or another?  
05: L. Exactly.  
06: Pollock: And pay everybody off.  
07: D. So they got uh...uh....Skippy Roberts got some money somewhere between  
08: Mia's house and you guys getting stopped by the state patrol?  
09: L. Exactly, the only place we was, was Leo's.  
10: D. Okay, uh...once you guys left the Spirit Lounge, okay, and your sister  
11: come back and said that Chip had already left the patrol barracks and was  
12: back in Buffalo or something like that, where did you guys go to from the  
13: Spirit Lounge?  
14: L. To Quality Farm and Fleet.  
15: D. Okay, who went in?  
16: L. I did.  
17: D. Okay, once you went in...  
18: L. He gave...Skip gave me some money and said, "go in there and get  
19: yourself a shirt, get me a shirt." I said, "okay, fine."  
20: D. So what kind of shirt? How much money did he give you?  
21: L. Uh....about \$30.00.  
22: D. Okay.  
23: L. \$35 a matter of fact.  
24: D. Alright and you went in?  
25: L. Yes I went in and uh...  
26: D. Was you bleeding anywhere down there?  
27: L. No sir.  
28: D. Okay, did Mr. Roberts get out of the car at anytime that you know of?  
29: L. No sir.  
30: D. Was he bleeding anytime by himself? Did he have any cuts on his arm  
31: or anything like that?  
32: L. No sir.  
33: D. Okay, uh...so once you went inside Quality Farm and Fleet...  
34: L. I bought two shirts.  
35: D. Okay, what was these shirts like?  
36: L. They was black t-shirts, had a wolf's head on them.  
37: D. Okay, both of them?  
38: L. Yes sir.  
39: D. Okay, did anybody make a comment about these two shirts being  
40: identical?  
41: L. Yeah my sister did. She said, "gee whiz, them are identical, you guys  
42: look like twins" or something to that effect.  
43: D. Okay, so after you did all that, your sister ended up taking you  
44: where?  
45: L. To Quaker City.  
46: D. Okay, um...  
47: Pollock: At anytime when you guys were out riding around like on Friday,  
48: did you stop in front of Leo Sinnett's house in the car with Mia, you,  
49: Skippy?  
50: L. Not that I can remember, no.

## STATEMENT

01: L. Not on Friday.  
02: Pollock: On Thursday did you?  
03: L. No.  
04: Pollock: Okay.  
05: L. To tell you the truth though, it's...it's....as far as I can remember,  
06: and being as drunk as I...I was pretty drunk. All this...this whole week  
07: that I had been down there, I mean, two to three cases of beer a day.  
08: D. Yeah.  
09: Pollock: Yeah, kind of wears on you.  
10: D. Saturday, did you guys....was you guys driving around Buffalo for a  
11: while?  
12: L. Yeah well...  
13: D. Did you guys drive by Leo's house a couple of times or anything like  
14: that?  
15: L. No.  
16: D. Okay, you just went there the one time and left.  
17: L. That's it.  
18: D. Okay.  
19: Pollock: After everything was over and you guys was in Noble County,  
20: when you ran.  
21: L. Okay.  
22: Pollock: Okay, was you ever threatened by anybody?  
23: L. Yes I was.  
24: Pollock: What was you told?  
25: L. I was told, that if I said anything against Skippy Roberts, that I was  
26: going to be as bad off if not worse then the old man.  
27: Pollock: Okay, do you know if Chip Andrews had any...what did...did Skip  
28: say anything about Chip Andrews?  
29: L. He said, that if he said anything, he was going to kill him.  
30: Pollock: Okay.  
31: L. He would get to him and he's able to get to him because he's got  
32: friends in prison, in the county jails, that's the truth right there.  
33: He threatened me and him.  
34: Pollock: Okay, getting back to the discussion and the money owed to Mia  
35: and everything, did Mia tell them that they shouldn't rob the guy or did  
36: she just kind of write it off?  
37: L. More or less just probably wrote it off like...like I did. I didn't  
38: think nothing like that.  
39: Pollock: Chip has a drug problem?  
40: L. Yes sir.  
41: Pollock: Skip evidently...our information is that he's got a problem too.  
42: L. I would say Mia does too.  
43: Pollock: Mia uses drugs along with them?  
44: L. I would say.  
45: D. Have you seen her use drugs?  
46: L. Yeah, that one night.  
47: D. Okay, what kind of drugs did you see Mia using?  
48: L. Crack.  
49: Pollock: So they all needed money. Saturday nobody got their checks?  
50: L. Exactly.

## STATEMENT

01: Pollock: Okay, so nobody had any money but you?  
02: L. I had just gotten it off my sister.  
03: Pollock: So you borrowed money from your sister.  
04: D. Which sister?  
05: L. Kimberly.  
06: Pollock: Okay.  
07: L. Which I didn't borrow it, she owed it to me. She borrowed it from  
08: me.  
09: D. So you just got your money?  
10: L. I just got my money back and she had come down. She was going to rent  
11: the house next to Mia's, Chip's house.  
12: Pollock: Okay.  
13: L. She was going to rent that house. I asked her, I said, "you got any  
14: money?" She gave me a \$20.00 bill, which she owed.  
15: D. Was...was Mia with you guys any Saturday except for getting the beer  
16: and stuff and riding around? Did they discuss that anymore Saturday  
17: about needing money and going up to get some more money off of anybody,  
18: other than what they had said Thursday?  
19: L. No, they never said anything, nothing. They never said anything about  
20: going to Leo's that day at all until we stopped right there and I was  
21: like, "wow, this is cool, I'll just go ahead and go down..." I was think-  
22: ing to myself, I would just go down to Jackie Dean's and get some money  
23: off of him now. I'm going to go ahead and do this, it would be fine.  
24: Pollock: After all of this happened, there's one question in my mind  
25: that just kind of sticks, why did you stick with Roberts and then after  
26: you split up that night when you ran, why didn't you turn yourself in?  
27: L. I have no idea, no idea, none whatsoever. I ask myself that every  
28: night.  
29: Pollock: If you would of come and told us and turned yourself in, then  
30: you know....  
31: D. Did Roberts say anything to you while you guys were out running  
32: together, did he say anything to you about the robbery that night?  
33: L. He just told me that he killed the guy and that if I said anything....  
34: D. Did he say what happened inside the house?  
35: L. He said, that he stabbed the guy.  
36: D. Yeah, but did he say they argued or he tried to get the money and he  
37: wouldn't give it to him or anything like that?  
38: L. There was nothing said about the money, nothing about no money.  
39: He just said, that he killed the guy. We went over to a place not in  
40: Quaker City, it's up more like over in...towards the back of the lake,  
41: over on Batesville side. A little bar and he called somebody and that's  
42: the guy that come up there and threatened me. He said, "if I said  
43: anything, that I'm as good as the old man."  
44: D. Okay, can you describe that guy?  
45: L. Yeah, he had dark hair, mustache, heavy set guy probably 250-275,  
46: somewhere in there, big guy, big biker guy and had tattoos. I really  
47: didn't pay much attention to the tattoos, but long...long hair.  
48: D. Okay, after you...after you guys knew that Mr. Roberts had committed  
49: the murder, he told you that on the way out or in the doorway, and you got  
50: back in the car with him and you drove away, okay, is there a reason in  
51: your own mind why you didn't say something to the patrol or somebody when  
52: you got a chance to be separate from them or call somebody else?

## STATEMENT

01: L. Well I...probably not, but I had been running from a DUI for the past  
02: year and to me, the sight of a cop just means going to jail.  
03: D. Okay.  
04: L. And I don't want to be in jail, but then again....  
05: D. But then when you were on the run by yourself knowing that Mr. Roberts  
06: had already killed Mr. Sinnett, you still didn't get a hold of anybody  
07: to let them know, hey you know....  
08: L. No I didn't.  
09: D. Okay.  
10: L. I didn't want...I didn't want to threaten my own life by letting  
11: anybody know where I was at.  
12: D. Okay.  
13: L. I didn't let nobody know up here what was going on, but my sister,  
14: Victoria come back and she was telling me about this and that and what  
15: was going on up there.  
16: D. So did you ever tell Victoria what happened in your own words?  
17: You never told her that you didn't have nothing to do with the killing?  
18: L. Yeah, I did tell her that I didn't have nothing to do with it after  
19: she come back from visiting my mother.  
20: D. Okay, do you...you indicated that you guys got the shirts, what  
21: happened to your black shirt?  
22: L. I didn't have a black shirt. I had a maroon shirt. I left it in  
23: Kimberly's car.  
24: D. Okay, but you don't know what happened to that afterwards?  
25: L. No, it should be still there.  
26: D. Okay.  
27: L. But the shirt that I had bought, it's probably at my buddy's house  
28: over here in Pennsylvania.  
29: D. Where at over here?  
30: L. Uh...Shacora, should be. Frank Komine's house.  
31: D. Where does he live at?  
32: L. Shacora.  
33: D. Okay, how far is that here from Butler?  
34: L. It's about 10 miles.  
35: D. Okay.  
36: L. A matter of fact, I know it's at my sister's house here.  
37: D. The shirt is?  
38: L. Yeah.  
39: Pollock: If we go down there, will you have any problems with us recover-  
40: ing it?  
41: L. You can have that, you can get that.  
42: D. Okay, is there anything else you would like to add or say at this  
43: time John?  
44: L. No sir.  
45: D. Okay, Ronnie?  
46: Pollock: No.  
47: D. Okay, the time now is 11:50 a.m. I'll conclude this statement at  
48: this time.
