Dear Skip,

I have received your letter of June 24, 2007. I have already filed my statement with the Court concerning your file, as previously ordered. I have advised the Court of the water damage to your records but there is no way that I can quantify that matter. I can't say for sure that it was during the flooding that those records were damaged but that would be entirely possible, given the amount of water we had. I don't believe I can give a verbal description of the damage that would be detailed enough to be of any value. It's basically a situation in which they have to be seen to appreciate which records are usable and which are not.

As for the motel receipt for Best Western, I do recall the issue but, after ten years, I can't recall the details of it. The transcript would have to be reviewed for that information.
