- #B-2. One (1) white envelope containing cotton swab of blood from home of John Tuttle.
- #B-3. One (1) brown paper bag containing towel with blood from home of John Tuttle.
- #B-4. One (1) brown paper sack containing clothes of Clarence D. Roberts.
- #B-6. One (1) plastic bag containing money and items belonging to Clarence D. Roberts. Money totals \$140.15.
- #B-7. One (1) Busch Light beer box containing seven (7) loose bottles of beer and one (1) loose bottle of beer in a brown paper bag.
- #B-12. One (1) plastic fishing rod case wrapped in green paper.
- #B-13. One (1) plastic bag containing leather gloves.

FINDINGS:

Laboratory examination of the contents of a small evidence box in Item #5 revealed the presence of bloody Caucasian body hair, hair fragments, and one apparent head hair. Comparison of the body hairs with samples of the hair standard found in Item #3 revealed them to be similar with respect to color and microscopic appearance.

Examination of the contents of Item #15 revealed the presence of one filter cigarette butt which is different from samples of cigarettes removed from a package of "Private Stock" cigarettes found in the car in Item #A-14.

Examination of the contents of Item #16 revealed the presence of one unfiltered cigarette butt which is different from the cigarettes found in the package in Item #A-14.

Laboratory examination revealed the presence of a human blood stain smear on the lower back of the front passenger seat of the white Cutlass car (Item #A 14).

FINDINGS: (cont.)

Examination revealed the presence of human blood stains on the Q-tip in Item #B-2 and on the terry cloth towel in Item #B-3.

The following samples are being retained for possible future comparisons: the cigarette butts in Items #15 and #16, the blood stains in Items #A-14, #B-2 and #B-3, samples of the blood standards in Items #2 and #11, and the saliva standard in Item #10.

Examination failed to reveal the presence of blood on articles found in Items #A-4, #A-10, #B-4, #B-6, #B-7, #B-12, or #B-13.

Nothing of apparent evidential value was found in the bags in Item #B-16.
