On Saturday, May 17th, I worked overtime from 4pm to 8pm working the Bvesville and Buffalo areas due to the Proms going on in the areas. I was sitting stationary on S.R.313 just west of Buffalo when I observed a white Oldsmobile heading west bound on S.R.313 coming out of Buffalo towards me. As I watched the vehicle, I observed it driving left of the center line. The vehicle drove by me at which time I noticed that the vehicle had no visible registration on it. I pulled out and pursued the vehicle at which time it drove off the right side of the roadway onto the gravel berm. The vehicle then attempted to pull into a private driveway as I activated my pursuit lights. The vehicle stopped after pulling completely into the driveway. I exited my patrol car as the driver and passengers were attempting to exit the car. I ordered the passengers to remain seated in the vehicle and told the driver to step away from the car. The driver was found to be Albert A. Andrews III, SSN#285724793. Mr. Andrews was found to be under the influence of alcohol and was arrested for D.U.I. I radioed for Tpr. Stolarik to assist me. As I waited for Tpr. Stolarik, I observed the right front passenger (Clarence Roberts) reach into the back seat and retrieve a black leather jacket at which time he put it on. Tpr. Stolarik arrived and C. Roberts was permitted to exit the vehicle to show proof of ownership for the car. We made contact with C. Roberts in front of my patrol car where he I.D. himself with a I.D. card and he gave us a title for the vehicle. Tpr. Stolarik observed a knife on C. Roberts side and he took the knife from him and secured it in his patrol car. Tpr. Stolarik and I noticed a large amount of blood on C. Roberts hands and the front portion of his pants between his waist line and knees. Tpr. Stolarik asked him about the blood on his hands and pants at which time Roberts made mention of processing a deer earlier. I observed the knife Tpr. Stolarik retrieved from Roberts and it appeared to have blood on it also. The knife was a solid steel with a double edged blade of about 3' or 4 inches.

As I spoke with Mr. Roberts, it was obvious he was intoxicated. After telling Roberts the disposition of the vehicle, I started the inventory sheet and turned it over to Tpr. Stolarik. I then sat in my patrol car with Albert Andrews as Tpr. Stolarik did the inventory. Tpr. Stolarik then showed me a almost full beer bottle which he located in the right front passenger seat area. I stated that we would not take enforcement action on it. C. Roberts was allowed to remove his personal belongings from the car due to it being towed. I left the scene and transported Mr. Andrews to the post for testing as Tpr. Stolarik remained at the stop waiting on the wrecker.
