CHIEF COMPLAINT: Medical clearance for foster placement.

HISTORY OF PRESENT ILLNESS: This 3-year-old little boy was brought by a social service counselor for evaluation prior to foster home placement with an aunt. He has been staying at the Women and Children Shelter for the last month.

He and his 2 siblings are to be placed later today, and medical clearance is required. The social worker is unable to give me much information although, by observation, the child has a dry, slightly irritated cough, minimal rhinorrhea.

The social circumstances are domestic violence and child abuse although the child has no signs of abuse today. He is a well-nourished little boy, pleasant, cooperative, playful, but cautious with the examiner.

REVIEW OF SYSTEMS: There are no reports of fever or chills, nausea or vomiting. No reports of decreased activities. I gained information from both the social worker, the patient, and the patient's older sister, and there is nothing to report.

PAST HISTORY:

Allergies: None.  
Medications: No current medications.  
Injuries: None known.  
Surgical History: None known.  
Illnesses: The past medical history is unknown although the social worker states that the aunt stated that the child had never been sick. Illnesses: None known.  
Hospitalizations: None.

FAMILY HISTORY: Family history is unavailable.

SOCIAL HISTORY: Has been staying at a shelter for children, and there is no history of any exposure to drugs, alcohol, or tobacco.

PHYSICAL EXAMINATION:

CONSTITUTIONAL: He is a well-nourished, well-developed, 3-year-old boy who is pleasant, and cooperative, well hydrated, and in no acute distress. His height, and weight, and general appearance are normal and correlate with his stated age.  
PSYCHIATRIC: Psychiatric examination is not done on this child.  
HEAD AND NECK: There are no marks, or abrasions, or bruises noted to the head, face, or neck. There are no scars to the face and no active lesions. The neck is supple. There is no adenopathy, no enlarged thyroid. No other masses.  
EYES: Normal.  
ENT: External auditory canals are normal. Tympanic membranes are normal. Nasal mucosa is congested, and there is a

Heart is regular with no murmurs.


GASTROINTESTINAL:
