TIME ARRIVED: 1359.

CHIEF COMPLAINT: Medical clearance prior to foster home placement.

HISTORY OF PRESENT ILLNESS: This 2-year-old little girl was brought by the social worker from the Cuyahoga County Family and Children Services for medical clearance. She has currently been in one of the homes in the city for distressed women and children and is to be placed with an aunt. She comes with her 2 siblings.

REVIEW OF SYSTEMS: There have been no recent problems with change in appetite, nausea, or vomiting. No evidence of upper respiratory infection and no complaints of pain or discomfort. Her activity levels are normal for a normal 2 year old.

PAST HISTORY:

Allergies: None known.
Medications: None.
Illnesses: Unfortunately, the past medical history is very sketchy, and little to nothing is known about prior illness; however, the social worker tells me that there have been no problems in the last month that she has been at the special residence.
Other: Immunization status is said to be current, but there is no clear evidence of that.

FAMILY HISTORY: Family history is not available.

SOCIAL HISTORY: Currently at a group home for distressed mothers and children.

PHYSICAL EXAMINATION:

VITAL SIGNS: Temperature is 98F. Pulse is 96. Respirations 20.
CONSTITUTIONAL: She is a well-nourished, well-developed, 2-year-old little girl who is pleasant, a little cautious with the examiner but cooperative with the examination. She is bright, and alert, and able to mimic actions of the examiner. Current weight is 28 pounds.
HEAD AND NECK: Atraumatic. Normocephalic. No facial tenderness. Neck is supple. No adenopathy, thyromegaly, or jugular venous distension.
EYES: PERLA. EOM intact.
ENT: Nasal passages are clear. Pharynx unremarkable. External canals normal. Tympanic membranes normal.
CHEST: The chest is symmetrical. Nontender.
RESPIRATORY: Lungs are clear.
CARDIOVASCULAR: Heart regular and rhythmic. No murmurs, gallops, rubs, or clicks.
GASTROINTESTINAL: The abdomen is slightly rounded, soft, nontender. Bowel sounds are present. No masses, no organomegaly, and no hernias.
EXTREMITIES: Joints are normal. Pulses are palpable centrally and peripherally.

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NEUROLOGICAL: Age-appropriate behavior. Gait is normal. No motor, sensory, or cerebellar signs. Reflexes are symmetrical.


TREATMENT PLAN:
