I am writing in concern of my husband, Grady Krzywkowski. Grady is not perfect as none of us are, but he certainly isn't capable of what he is being charged with. Even though we have made some parenting mistakes we both love our children very deeply. I know that Grady would never intentionally hurt our children in this way or any other way. On the day our first child was born Grady was overwhelmed with emotions of love and happiness. He cried the first he saw and held every one of the children. As they grew so did our love for them. Together we became eagerly excited over every birthday and the milestones to follow. Grady and I both always love them. We are always proud of them. Right now we are both hurting deeper than most can understand because we miss them. Yes we have both made mistakes but we are not these horrible monsters we are being made out to be. Which only makes the pain worse. Our worst nightmare has come true. Our children are gone and we only know they are somewhere in Toledo. When we ask about them we get a simple fine, which of course, is certainly not enough. A daycare provider could give me a longer report for an hour's time. So we are left hopeless and scared as our family has been shattered by this system designed to help people. Help and skills we may have needed but this certainly is not help at all.

I can assure you if these things Grady is charged with occurred in our home there would have been unmistakable signs. Signs that would have been impossible to overlook. I love my children very much, and this breaks my heart. It scares me, because Grady didn't do this. So if it did indeed happen some individual out there who did this is still out there and probably still doing it. That is scary.

I know that in the bottom of my soul Grady did not do this. When he was arrested for this, and I saw how those men treated him with complete disrespect it broke my heart. His rights were not read to him. They refused to produce a warrant and identification, and they were rough and loud. I couldn't bear to see him like that. I have been married to Grady for seven years. He is my husband, the father of my children, my lover, my best friend, and partner for all in life. This is how I see him and know him to be, my opinion. I realize your job is not easy and it requires you to make decisions that effect many lives which must take a very strong and fair person to do so, I have complete confidence in you. If you see things differently than I do then I respect that and know that you have good reasons. If for some reason or another you do see things differently please I beg and pray for you to be lenient, and to remember all the people behind this man. Thank you for taking the time to read this letter and for considering my thoughts.

I am writing to you about Grady Krzywkowski. First of all let me say I am not the enemy. I don't know if anything that I say to you can help you, but I am hoping. I know that Grady did not do the things he is being charged with. I know this because these things are so brutal, and as the mother of these children there would have been unmistakable signs. Signs I could not have missed while bathing the children or washing their clothing, or just from being with them every day, but there were none. I also feel the county for some reason or another just does not want us to have our children. They have broken promises to us, they have lied to us, they have made off record threats to me, they have torn our family apart and destroyed our lives. There was domestic violence in our home, but nothing compared to what they are trying to say happened. I am scared for Grady and I am afraid of the county. I love my husband very much, the county however has left me torn and confused, they have told me that if I stay with him I will never see my children again. The case plan goal says reunification, however even after doing everything they have asked me to do, I still have not seen my children since July 27th, 2000. The GAL is also another person who scares me. She has told me that she doesn't see me seeing my children and that Grady will be in prison for a long time, she also told me that I am afraid of Grady, and that's why she believes I let this happen. This never happened, I tried to tell her, but she refuses to listen. A detective at third district police station told me he would hesitate to knock Grady out. I believe there is something very wrong here, even with the system being as messed up as it is, something is still very wrong. Anyway I am not asking you for any information, just if I can help you in any way or if there are any questions you may have, I wanted you to know that I am here. I am scared but I am want to help if I can. Thank you for caring about Grady and believing in him.
