Note: The identification of a Family's Needs & Strengths is part of a Structured Decision Making process. Family Strengths are identified as supportive building blocks for planning effective interventions & activities to help families meet their needs & reduce the risk of harm to their children. A Family's Priority Needs are identified as those needs or problems which have the greatest impact on future risk of abuse & neglect and must be addressed immediately. Priority Needs identified in Section 2B will have detailed plans outlined in Section 3. Detailed plans for Secondary Needs identified in Section 2C may be included, or amended into the case plan Section 3 more specifically at a later date. Often times, working on Secondary Needs is not possible or advisable while Priority Needs remain. The Family Assessment is the primary source for case planning in cases where children remain in their own home or have a goal of reunification. The Child's Assessment will be the focus in those cases where the goal is planned permanent living arrangement, independent living, or adoption. Child's Needs Assessment results are noted in Part B, Section 3, c.

Parties must fully understand that any identification & sequencing of needs & strengths is subject to change pending further reassessments and may result in case plan amendments to assure the most effective planning & services.
