1 is appropriate to take all of the time in front of the jury,
2 but I will certainly, if what you want is the right to recall
3 the agent, in the mean time to do something, I don't have a

17 kilos from Colombia, Mexico, and U.S.?

18 A. Not for that particular load, no.

19 Q. Now, you gave testimony that Mr. Dean was supposed to have
20 gone to Colombia, or something, concerning an agreement of his
21 to go down to Colombia?

22 A. Yes.

23 Q. As best you know from all of the information you have, did
24 Mr. Dean ever go down to Colombia?

25 A. Not to my knowledge, no.
