AFFIDAVIT of PROBABLE CAUSE

On April 19, 1998 at about 1:00 pm York city police were called to 223 East Philadelphia Street to investigate an open door at that address. Upon their arrival, police discovered the second floor rear apartment door had been broken. Looking further police found the body of Manuel Santana on the kitchen floor, several feet inside the door. After finding the body of Santana of Santana, police found the body of Miriam Asencio in an adjoining bedroom. Both victims' bodies were removed from the scene and taken to Lehigh Valley Hospital where autopsies were preformed on April 20, 1998. As a result autopsy reports show both victims died from stab wounds. Police in the course of their investigation interview witnesses that state on April 19, 1998, in the early morning hours they heard Milton Montalvo beating on the second floor rear apartment yelling, "Let me in!" Witnesses then heard glass crash, then screaming and yelling and thumping on the floor and walls. After several minutes there was silence. Witnesses also state that on April 19, 1998, at approx 7:00 am, they had a conversation with Milton Motalvo and his brother Noel Matos Montalvo. The witnesses state that Noel said that he was the one who killed Miriam Asencio, and he described how he killed her.

Based on the above information I am requesting a warrant for Noel Matos Montalvo charging him with Criminal Homicide, Criminal Conspiracy to commit Homicide, and Burglary.

I, DET R. CAMACHO, BEING DULY SWORN ACCORDING TO LAW, DEPOSE AND SAY THAT THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE FOREGOING AFFIDAVIT ARE TRUE AND CORRECT TO THE BEST OF MY KNOWLEDGE, INFORMATION, AND BELIEF.
