

1 Q Mr. Swift, I'm going to direct your attention to November
2 12, 1980. Where did you live on that date?
3 A I lived at 2631 Jules Street.
4 Q Here in St. Joseph, Missouri?
5 A Yes, sir.
6 Q Back in November of 1980, did you know Patricia Jeschke?
7 A Yes, I did.
8 Q How long had you known her prior to November 12, 1980?
9 A I'd say approximately five years.
10 Q Now, Mr. Swift, did you work that day, November 12, 1980?
11 A Yes, I did.
12 Q Where did you work at?
13 A St. Joseph Terminal Railroad.
14 Q Do you recall on that date what time you got off work?
15 A I'd say approximately twenty to five, a quarter to five,
16 somewhere in there.
17 Q After you got off at twenty to five or a quarter to five,
18 where did you go?
19 A I went to the main post office and dropped off some letters.
20 That's part of the job I was working.
21 Q The downtown post office?
22 A Right.
23 Q From there, where did you go?
24 A Down 10th Street and turned there like at Frederick, around
25 by city hall and up Jules to go home.

1 Q Going up Jules, did you see Patricia Jeschke?

2 A Yes, I did.

3 Q Where did you see her?

4 A Approximately 13th, 14th and Jules, thereabouts.

5 Q Was she driving her automobile?

6 A Yes, she was.

7 Q What kind of automobile did she have?

8 A It was an MG, I believe MG Midget, a small sports car.

9 Q A small two-seated sports car?

10 A Yes.

11 Q Did you in fact wave or do anything with Patricia, acknow-
12 ledge seeing her?

13 A Oh, I waved at her.

14 Q Did you pull next to her?

15 Q It's a one-way street. I was in one lane-- I was in the
16 left-hand lane; she was in the right-hand lane.

17 Q Approximately what area of Jules Street did you see her
18 again?

19 A I'd say it was around 12th, 13th, somewhere in there. On
20 the other side of city hall, somewhere in that vicinity.

21 Q Was anybody in the sports car with her?

22 A Not that I saw, no.

23 Q When was the last time you saw Patricia Jeschke in this
24 sports car?

25 A Probably around 19th Street, 22nd. I passed her, went on.
