This is in further response to your request of August 3, 1987, and supplements our letter of August 21, 1987.





This is in response to your Privacy Act request of June 26, 1987, for information pertaining to the U.S. Army Criminal Investigation Laboratory (USACIL) report numbered 82-CID331-00339-FP-C. Your request was referred to this headquarters by our USACIL-Pacific, Camp Zama, Japan, and was received on July 16, 1987.

Coordination with USACIL-Pacific revealed that the latent fingerprints contained on the six (6) 3 x 5 cards listed on document #094-82 have not been identified with a named individual. Also, there is no indication that these latent prints were submitted as physical evidence in any other investigation.
