## FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION

Date of transcription 05/07/98

Anthony Thomas, Black male, who was familiar with the identity of the interviewing Agent and the nature of the interview, advised that he had called the recording studio following the alleged assault upon him and was told by "Chico," a Black male, short in stature, approximately 5'8", 180 pounds, with dark short hair, that individuals inside the recording studio had witnessed the attempted car jacking upon Thomas.

Chico advised Thomas that the light skinned Black male, who was involved in the attempted car jacking, was known as "KT," who was a tall, thin Black male who was wearing a black leather coat. Chico also advised that Dexter Rasco was involved in the attempted car jacking and was hiding behind the northeastern corner of the building just prior to the attempted car jacking.

Furthermore, Thomas advised that Dewayne Julks, who was arrested at the scene of the attempted car jacking, is known in the community as "Little Rab."

Dexter Andre Rasco, Black male, date of birth August 22, 1972, was contacted at 1717 East Genesee in reference to the apparent assault that had just occurred there upon Anthony Thomas. After being advised of the identity of the interviewing Agent and the nature of the interview Rasco provided the following information:

Rasco, who was loitering in the area at the time of the assault, advised that he had walked to the record recording studio from his stepfather, Albert Gibson's residence, at 502 South 14th Street. Rasco, who was looking for "Possum", talked to "whoever" inside the front door. "Whoever, told Rasco that "Possum" was not there. Rasco walked away from the front door and "saw a whole bunch a people."

At this point in the interview, Rasco became unresponsive to questioning and continued to say "whatever." He then explained that he, "didn't see nothin." Rasco identified the occupant of the Cadillac Seville as "Chan."

The following investigation was conducted by SA Paul T. Cowley:

At approximately 8:00 p.m. on March 25, 1998, SA Paul T. Cowley, Coordinator, Saginaw Bay Gang Task Force, was a passenger in an unmarked police vehicle driven by Detective/Sergeant Michael Vanhorn, Michigan State Police, Saginaw Bay Gang Task Force. While heading north on West Genesee across from the Circle Seven Convenience Store, south of Atwater, SA Cowley noticed an assault in progress in the parking lot located in front of the "Play Style Studio," 1717 East Genesee, Saginaw, Michigan.

SA Cowley noticed a Black male, approximately 30 years old, wearing a dark/black jacket, assaulting the occupant of a cream/champagne colored, 1992 Cadillac Seville. The occupant, a Black male, was seated in the driver's seat and was subsequently identified as Anthony Thomas. There were at least three individuals who had surrounded the vehicle. Upon approaching the vehicle, the individual who was assaulting the driver, fled west on foot behind the building as did another light complected Black male who fled in the same direction.

At that time, Thomas exited his vehicle and said that "Peter Rabbit" was the individual who had assaulted him, as well as two other Black males, one being the aforementioned light complected Black male and another Black male, who was in custody at the scene, was identified by Thomas as the third attacker. (This person was identified at the scene as Dwayne Julks, date of birth April 14, 1977.)

Thomas advised that he knew Peter Rabbit only by reputation and did not know Julks or the identity of the other light complected Black male, but believed he could identify him if he saw him again.

Thomas incurred an injury to his nose which was bleeding from the left nostril and had bled upon his jacket. Furthermore, he had a swelling on his right cheekbone and a number of apparent nail scratches and an abrasion on the front of his right shoulder and clavicle area.
