Robert Mason, Black male, telephonically contacted SA Paul T. Cowley at the Saginaw Bay Gang Task Force. Mason, who was familiar with the identity of the Agent, advised that he was back in town. Mason stated he was living in Wilmington, Delaware. Mason said he'd recently read a transcript about a pending drug indictment involving Derrick Peterson and the transcript implicated Mason in the drug conspiracy.

Mason inquired about the status of Thomas Wicker's case. Mason stated that he would handle Wicker personally before he would lie in court about him. Mason stated that his testimony in that court trial was truthful. Mason said that it was much more difficult to testify in court about that matter than it would have been to take care of it himself.

Mason was asked whether anyone, including anyone from the FBI, had asked him to wrongfully accuse Wicker of that assault against Anthony Thomas and himself. Mason responded that he testified of his "own freewill" and that nobody influenced his testimony.

Mason advised that he could be reached through his mother.
