

1 **MR. GUST:** I have no further questions of this
2 witness, Your Honor.

3 **MR. DUGGAN:** No further questions.

4 **THE COURT:** Any questions from the jury?
5 If there are no questions, you may be excused.

6 **MR. GUST:** Your Honor, we have exhibits marked
7 Exhibit 18, 19, 20, 21, 22 and 23, which are
8 photographs of -- I believe Mr. Duggan will stipulate
9 photographs of the car of Anthony Thomas, photographs
10 taken of the vehicle at the crime lab showing the
11 damages from the -- from bullets and from whatever
12 other causes there are. I would ask to publish those
13 to the jury.

14 **MR. DUGGAN:** I'd stipulate to their admission. I
15 would state counsel was -- wouldn't have this personal
16 knowledge but I wouldn't either. I got it from
17 Detective Sanchez. We obtained them from the crime
18 laboratory because they did the separate part of the
19 investigation. I'll so stipulate for the receipt of
20 those as the condition of the victim's vehicle after
21 this incident.

22 **THE COURT:** They will be received and published
23 to the jury.

24 **MR. GUST:** It's also -- we also have a
25 stipulation, Your Honor, regarding that vehicle after

1 that alleged previous incident in March was taken to
2 the crime lab and checked for fingerprints. It's
3 our -- our stipulation that although fingerprints were
4 found, none were the fingerprints matching the
5 fingerprints of the defendant, Thomas Wicker.

6 **THE COURT:** Is that correct, Mr. Duggan?

7 **MR. DUGGAN:** Well, I'll -- I'd like to know if
8 this stipulation will include that they also had the
9 opportunity to look for fingerprints as a result of
10 the shooting incident. And so with respect to both, I
11 would stipulate that a check for fingerprints did not
12 reveal any identifiable fingerprints of the defendant.

13 Counsel wanted also to add some other
14 identifiable fingerprints. We won't get into whose.
15 I don't think it's pertinent, but I agree to that
16 stipulation.

17 **THE COURT:** Okay. The stipulation then may be
18 considered by the jury as evidence in this case.

19 **MR. GUST:** Thank you, Your Honor.

20 **MR. DUGGAN:** At this time the People rest.

21 **THE COURT:** Okay. Mr. Gust, it's 25 minutes to
22 5. I suppose your case might take a little longer
23 than we have left.

24 **MR. GUST:** Yes, Your Honor, and because of the
25 nature of the way the case has gone, I've informed --
